ROGAINING is the sport of long-distance cross-country day & night-time navigation. Teams travel on foot, navigating between checkpoints set in variable terrain, aiming to visit as many checkpoints as possible in the allocated time. Some are out to win; others just for fun. A central base, the Hash House, provides meals during the event. A great introduction to ROGAINING is the METROGAINE, which leads teams through urban areas placing less reliance on compass navigation & bush craft.
